REFUND POLICY FOR FIRST AID & BOAT COURSES

All Boat & First Aid Courses require 100% attendance. Late admission can not be granted. For this reason, cancellation requests must be submitted a **minimum of five (5) business days** prior to the start of the first class in order to receive a refund. **No refund will be issued for late requests.**

BOAT COURSE (Boat Operator Accredited Training)

Attention all operators of motorized craft...Did you know **ALL boaters** will require a Canadian Coast Guard Pleasure Craft Operator Card to operate any motorized boat by 2009. If you were born after April 1, 1983, you need it NOW. To drive any powered boat under 4m, you must have your card NOW! The card can be obtained by successfully writing the Canadian Coast Guard operator certification test. To prepare you for the test, we are offering an Accredited Canadian Coast Guard Boater Safety Standards Course. The purpose: to have a common level of safe boating knowledge by all water craft operators in Canada. Classroom only, this course will teach: boating regulations and legalities; operation and use of equipment; skills, emergency responses, attitudes, etc. All successful candidates will be issued their own Operators Card. Cost includes course, study guide, exam, & certification upon successful completion.

EMERGENCY FIRST AID / CPR B

For people who want a general knowledge of first aid principles and the emergency treatment of injuries. Skills include victim assessment, rescue breathing, CPR, choking and what to do for external bleeding, heart attack and stroke.

STANDARD FIRST AID / CPR C – WSIB approved

Provides comprehensive training covering all aspects of first aid and CPR. Standard First Aid incorporates all of Emergency First Aid and is designed for those who require a more in-depth understanding of first aid including legal implications of first aid treatment, spinal injuries, heat or cold injuries, bone and joint injuries, abdominal and chest injuries, burns, and medical emergencies.
