

**ESTIMATE OF MAXIMUM CAMPAIGN EXPENSES
BASED UPON ELECTORAL INFORMATION FROM WARD BOUNDARY REVIEW**

The Town amended the Ward Boundaries in 2009 and as a result the Electoral Information from the 2006 election is no longer relevant. The electoral information noted below is from the Elector Count Extract provided by MPAC, dated Dec 14, 2009. Polling subdivisions will need to be realigned and that work will be completed prior to March 31st, 2010.

1. There is a limit of \$750 per individual contribution.
2. A contributor shall not make contributions exceeding a total of \$5,000.00 to candidates running for office on the same Council.
3. Limits are placed on expenses based on a formula relating to the number of electors. For the office of the Mayor, it is \$7,500 + 85 cents per elector. For all other offices it is \$5,000 + 85 cents per elector in each ward.

Information regarding York Region District Board Trustees for the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville cannot be determined until the School Board boundaries have been finalized which will take place prior to March 31st, 2010. During the 2006 election, the Town shared a School Board trustee with the Town of East Gwillimbury. The School Board will advise the Town as to the trustee distribution for 2010 once the boundaries have been established.

Prior to **September 20th, 2010**, the Clerk will send by registered mail a copy of the Final Campaign Spending Limit advising as to the amount of total campaign expenses that may be incurred by each certified Candidate. A **NEW** provision in the Act permits Candidates to use the higher amount of either the Estimate of Maximum Campaign Expenses or the Final Maximum Campaign Expenses limit.
