

FEE/DEPOSIT REQUIRED AT TIME OF FILING NOMINATION

The following fee/deposit is payable by:

- **Cash (or debit),**
- **Certified cheque made payable to the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville; or**
- **Money order made payable to the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville.**

1. **Office of Mayor** **\$200**
2. **Office of Councillor or School Board Trustee** **\$100**

The filing fee is pursuant to Section 1 (1) of Ontario Regulation 101/97 and Section 33 (2) (c) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*.

Section 1 (1) of Ontario Regulation 101/97

- 1 (1) For the purpose of clause 33 (2) (c) of the Act, the prescribed nomination filing fee is \$100 except for the office of head of council of a municipality, in which case the filing fee is \$200.

Section 33 (2) (c) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*.

The nomination shall,

- 33 (2) (c) be accompanied by the prescribed nomination filing fee.

A candidate is entitled to a refund of the nomination filing fee if he or she withdraws the nomination, is elected to the office or receives more than 2% of the percentage of the votes cast in the election for that office.

3. **Sign deposit (pursuant to By-law 2004-75- RE)**..... **\$230**

All Candidates are required to post a sign deposit.

Pursuant to the sign by-law, "Any election sign erected or installed in violation of this by-law shall be removed under the direction of the clerk and any costs associated with this removal shall be deducted from the sign permit deposit fee at a cost of **\$10.00** per sign."

Candidates are entitled to a refund of the sign deposit, or the remaining portion thereof, after October 28th, 2010.
