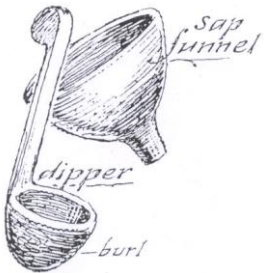

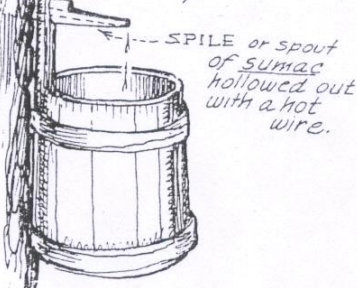

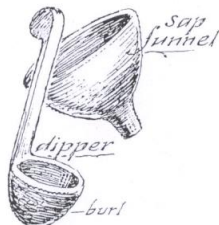


Sap Spoon

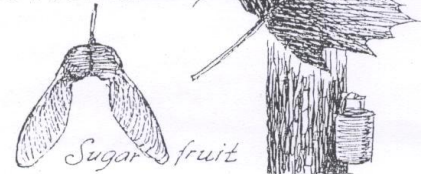
