

2. ALTERNATIVE USES FOR 19 CIVIC AVENUE (C10-DV & A19)

- 1) THAT the themes for alternate uses for 19 Civic Avenue be narrowed to Option No. 4, namely the Arts / Culture & Tourism themes, as set out in this Report;
- 2) AND THAT Staff embark upon a "testing and business evaluation" phase with the technical assistance of professionals and community resources with expertise in the disciplines of urban design / architecture, retail and facility recruitment, marketing, and financial analysis which shall serve the purpose of refining the merits of Option No. 4 and identify viable program elements;
- 3) AND THAT Staff be authorized to expend up to \$15,000 for the "testing and business evaluation" phase with the funding to be drawn from the 2006 Capital Budget for Downtown Revitalization reserve;
- 4) AND THAT Staff return to Council with a further Report in June 2006 on the preliminary business case plan for a preferred option and any recommendations on the project as it relates to the Capital Budget.

THAT a recorded vote be requested. The Clerk called the question and asked each member of Council in turn.
